## **TURF TALK:** Why do we not cut greens on certain days??

We cut greens Tues- thru Sun. At times when we fertilize we will go one or two days without cutting the greens. The turf needs sunlight to hit the leaves of the turf to start photosynthesis. So, when there is less leaf surface there is less photosynthesis occurring. This is why we like to let the turf grow one day a week on the greens, meaning no cut on Mondays. It is cut so short, .145cm or 9/64" or 3.6 mm. Do we all realize what we are saying here 3.6mm. The fertilizer will just sit on the turf and not get into the soil. At \$59.00 per bag we use 13 bags, that's \$767.00 total for a one time application. we need to get as much if not all of the fertilizer in the soil as possible. The rough and fwys are of course at a longer length which allows fertilizer to fall in between the leaves and thus allowing us to cut it sooner.
